Re: Expanded Urgent Recall Notification – BrucePac-Ready-to-Eat Poultry Products Due to Contamination

Dear URM Representative

This letter serves as an updated notification regarding of the Class I recall issued on October 10, 2024, concerning BrucePac Ready-To-Eat Meat and Poultry Products. This recall has been expanded due to potential contamination with *Listeria monocytogenes*. The attached documentation provides details on the expanded date ranges for the affected products you have purchased.

These poultry products were utilized as ingredients in various frozen entrées (see separate attachments). The contamination was identified following notification from BrucePac that specific batches of their Ready-to-Eat-Poultry Products were contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes*.

We began shipping these products on July 19, 2024, and at this time, no injuries or illnesses have been reported in connection with the affected product lot.

As a precaution, a voluntary recall has been issued for these products, and we are notifying you that shipments made to your facility are included in this recall. Enclosed, you will find a list of the affected products, including the details of the warehouses where they were shipped. Additionally, product labels have been provided to assist in identifying both individual units and full cases.

Actions Required:

1. Immediate Inventory Review:

- Review your inventory for any affected products.
- Quarantine any identified products immediately.

2. Record-Keeping and Destruction:

- Record the total number of items associated with the affected code dates
- Perform a witnessed destruction of the quarantined products.
- Complete and return the enclosed Response Form and Witness Destruction Form as soon as possible.

3. If Products Have Been Distributed Further:

- Identify and notify your customer without delay.
- Provide them with a copy of this recall notification and ensure they follow the same procedures for witnessed destruction and documentation.
- Return their completed Response Forms and Witnessed Destruction Forms as soon as possible.

Please note that this recall extends to the retail level, and prompt action is essential to mitigate any risk to consumers.

This recall has been initiated with the full knowledge and oversight of the United States Department of Agriculture.

Thank you for your immediate attention to this matter. Your cooperation is essential in ensuring consumer safety.
